HOUSE BILL NO. 675

AN ACT to amend Chapter 261 of the Private Acts of 1978; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the Hawkins County planning commission.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 261 of the Private Acts of 1978; and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by deleting the last two sentences in Section 1 and by substituting instead the following:

Members of the Planning Commission shall receive the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per meeting for attendance at any and all sessions of the Hawkins County Planning Commission or the same amount as members of committees appointed from the Hawkins County Legislative Body are paid per each meeting, whichever is greater. Members must be present at an authorized meeting of the commission in order to receive the above compensation.

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of Hawkins County. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the legislative body of Hawkins County and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 2.
