AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 12-2-202, relative to advertisement and public sale of confiscated items.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 12-2-202, is amended by adding the following language as a new subsection (c):

(c) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, including, but not limited to, provisions related to the manner of advertisement, the commissioner is hereby authorized to dispose of, by advertising on the Internet and selling by Internet auction, confiscated intoxicating beverages, confiscated motor vehicles and any other lawfully confiscated property.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2008, the public welfare requiring it.
