AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 5, Chapter 21, relative to surplus property.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 5, Chapter 21, is amended by adding the following language as a new section:

5-21-1\_\_.

In addition to any other methods for sales of county-owned property authorized by law, any county having adopted the County Financial Management System of 1981 is authorized to conduct a sale of county-owned property that has become surplus, obsolete, or unusable on any Internet auction web site that is approved by the county's financial management committee.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
