AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 68 and Title 69, relative to directing a feasibility study concerning the development of an online subsurface sewage disposal system permitting process.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. The commissioner of environment and conservation is directed to conduct a feasibility study concerning the development of an online subsurface sewage disposal system permitting process. The study shall address the prospective application of such a permitting process, the availability of online service throughout the state, funding for the establishment of the permitting process and other relevant issues. The commissioner of environment and conservation shall report on the findings of this study on or before January 20, 2009, to the house conservation and environment committee of the house of representatives, and the senate environment conservation and tourism committee.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
