

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 647

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Mr. Lowell W. Perry, Jr. to the Board of Directors of the Tennessee Education Lottery Corporation.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 451101, provides for the creation of the Tennessee Education Lottery Corporation; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 451103, provides that the governor shall appoint seven members to the Board of Directors of the Tennessee Education Lottery Corporation; and

WHEREAS, Governor Phil Bredesen recently reappointed Mr. Lowell W. Perry, Jr. of Franklin, Tennessee, as a member of the Board of Directors of the Tennessee Education Lottery Corporation; Mr. Perry will serve a five (5) year term that will expire on June 30, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Lowell Perry, a native of Detroit, Michigan, is a graduate of Yale University with a bachelor's degree in administrative sciences; and

WHEREAS, Lowell Perry is currently the Chief Executive Officer of Big Brothers Big Sisters of Middle Tennessee. Mr. Perry serves as Principal of LPJ Enterprises, Inc. Previously, Mr. Perry served as President/Chief Operating Officer of Detroit Technologies, Inc. in Southfield, Michigan from 1996-1999. Mr. Perry also served as Integrated Marketing Manager of Allied Domecq Spirits & Wine in Southfield, Michigan from 1994-1996; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Perry serves on the Board of the Association of NonProfit Executives, Community Advisory Council. He is also a member of the Benchmark Diversity Council of Big Brother Big Sisters of America and the Nashville Chamber of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 451103(f), provides that each member appointed by the governor to the Board of Directors of the Tennessee Education Lottery Corporation shall be confirmed by joint resolution of the General Assembly; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, that we hereby confirm the appointment of Mr. Lowell W. Perry, Jr. to the Board of Directors of the Tennessee Education Lottery Corporation for a five (5) year term to expire on June 30, 2011.
