AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 54, Chapter 17, relative to scenic roadways.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 54-17-114(a)(2), is amended by adding the following language as a new subdivision:

(DD) That portion of United States Highway 441 (Newfound Gap Road) in Sevier County from the city limits of the city of Gatlinburg to the Tennessee - North Carolina state line.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
