AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102, relative to consumption of alcoholic beverages on the premises of an historic interpretive center.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102(16), is amended by deleting subdivision (A) in its entirety and by substituting instead the following language:

(A) The center is located in an historic area of town where structures listed on the national register of historic places are located;

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102(16), is further amended in subdivision (B) by deleting the language "is leased and operated by a for-profit corporation, or not-for-profit corporation" and by substituting instead the language "operates as a not-for-profit corporation"; and by deleting the last two sentences of the subdivision and by substituting instead the following language:

Alcoholic beverages may be consumed inside the center at locations designated by the board of the not-for-profit corporation.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
