AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57, Chapter 5, Part 1, relative to beer and alcoholic beverages.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-5-101(c)(1)(A), is amended by deleting the language "five thousand (5,000) barrels" and substituting instead the language "twenty-five thousand (25,000) barrels".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-5-101(c)(1)(B), is amended by deleting the period at the end of the subdivision and by adding the following language:

or as a hotel as defined under § 57-4-102(19)(F)(iii); provided that such hotel licensee shall only sell beer manufactured pursuant to this section on the premises of such hotel.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
