AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 62, Chapter 3, Part 1, relative to animals permitted in barbershops.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 62, Chapter 3, Part 1, is amended by adding a new section thereto, as follows:

Section 62-3-132. No animals, except service animals, fish for decorative purposes, and birds in cages, shall be permitted in any barber shop. Bird cages in barber shops shall be cleaned daily. Departmental inspectors shall ensure bird cages are cleaned sufficiently to prevent any hazard to human health or well-being.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
