AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-21-1001, relative to county registers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-21-1001, is amended by deleting subsection (i) in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

(i)(1) Notwithstanding any provision of this section or other law to the contrary, any revenue collected from data processing fees above an amount necessary to purchase computer equipment and software, upgrades to computer equipment and software, and supplies, maintenance and services relating to computer equipment and software by a register in any county having a population of:

<u>not less than:</u>	<u>nor more than:</u>
26,700	26,800
31,300	31,400
69,400	69,500
182,000	182,100
307,800	307,900

according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census, may be utilized for other purposes directly related to the official function of such office.

(2) Prior to any purchase relating to the official function of the register from revenue collected above an amount necessary for purchasing, upgrading, supplying and maintaining computer equipment and software by the register's office as provided in subdivision (i)(1), the register shall obtain the approval of the county legislative body for such purchase.

(3) The provisions of this subsection (i) shall only be effective in any county to which this subsection applies upon the adoption of a resolution by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the county legislative body of such county.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
