AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 8, Chapter 30, Part 2, relative to residence of employees.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-30-201(c), is amended by designating the existing language as subdivision (1) and by adding the following language, to be designated as subdivision (2):

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (1) or any other law to the contrary, all supervisory personnel, during the time such person is employed by the state to hold such position, shall be physically present in Tennessee while supervising employees working within Tennessee unless business reasons require out-of-state travel. Supervisory personnel shall include any person who oversees, directs or manages the work, work flow, or employees in the performance of their daily duties.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
