AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102, relative to consumption of alcoholic beverages at certain premier type tourist resorts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102 (24)(D)(ii), is amended by adding the following language after “to” and before “the”: “a federally protected forest, such as”.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102(24)(D)(iii), is amended by adding the following language after “rooms” and before “in”: “or residential or rental cabins”.

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102(24)(D)(v), is amended by adding the following language after “area of” and before “the”: “at least two (2) of the”.

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102(24)(D), is amended by deleting subdivision (vi).

SECTION 5. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102 (24)(D) is amended by adding the following as new, appropriately designated subdivisions thereto:

() Does not discriminate against any patron on the basis of age, gender, race, religion or national origin;

() Is located in any county having a population of not less than one hundred five thousand eight hundred (105,800) nor more than one hundred five thousand nine hundred (105,900) according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census;

() Any restaurant or recreational facility owned by the corporation or partnership and open to the public that is located on the premises described under this subdivision (24)(D) may exercise the privileges authorized under this chapter;

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
