AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 56, Chapter 7, and Title 71, Chapters 3 and 5, relative to state authorized health plans.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 56-7-2916, is amended by deleting the date "June 30, 2010" and by substituting instead the date "June 30, 2015".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 56-7-3002, is amended by deleting the date "June 30, 2012" in subsection (a)(9)(B) and in subsection (b) and by substituting instead the date "June 30, 2015" and by deleting the date "June 30, 2010" in subsection (b) and by substituting instead the date "June 30, 2015".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 56-7-3005, is amended by deleting the date "June 30, 2012" in subsection (c)(3)(B) and in subsection (g) and by substituting instead the date "June 30, 2015".

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 56-7-3027, is amended by deleting the date "June 30, 2012" in subsection (h) and in subsection (i) and by substituting instead the date "June 30, 2015".

SECTION 5. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 56-7-3028, is amended by deleting the date "June 30, 2010" and the date "June 30, 2012" and by substituting instead the date "June 30, 2015".

SECTION 6. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 71-3-1113, is amended by deleting the date "June 30, 2010" and by substituting instead the date "June 30, 2015".

SECTION 7. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 71-5-2505(12), is amended by deleting the date "June 30, 2010" and by substituting instead the date "June 30, 2015".

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
