AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-24-112, relative to minimum training for firefighters.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-24-112(g)(1), is amended by inserting the figure "17,700" under the column heading "not less than" below the figure "17,600" under such heading, and by inserting the figure "17,775" under the column heading "nor more than" below the figure "17,675" under such heading.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-24-112(g), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

() Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, if a firefighter located in a county or a municipality located within a county having a population of not less than seventeen thousand seven hundred (17,700) nor more than seventeen thousand seven hundred seventy-five (17,775), according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census, is exempt from meeting the minimum training requirements established pursuant to this section, then the pay supplement authorized pursuant to § 4-24-202 for firefighters completing the in-service training course shall not be available to such a firefighter unless the firefighter meets the minimum training requirements established pursuant to this section.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
