AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4; Title 8; Title 9 and Title 67, relative to the operation of government.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-3-1105(9), is amended by deleting the language ", including the state capitol and capitol annexes," and by substituting instead the following:

, including the state capitol and capitol annexes except as otherwise provided by § 4-8-101(a)(2),

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-8-101(a), is amended by deleting the subsection and by substituting instead the following:

(a)

(1) Except as otherwise provided by subdivision (2), it is the duty of the department of general services, through the commissioner, to take care of and preserve the state capitol and capitol annexes and all the furniture, fixtures and the capitol grounds, and to keep the same in good order.

(2) It is the duty of the department of general services, through the commissioner acting with approval of the speaker of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives, to take care of and preserve the second floor of the state capitol, including all chambers, galleries, offices, rooms, hallways, balconies, storage areas and other spaces therein, and all associated furniture and fixtures and to keep the same in good order.

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-8-201(a), is amended by deleting the language "assigned a minimum of four (4) parking spaces" and by substituting instead the following:

assigned a minimum of six (6) parking spaces

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010, the public welfare requiring it.
