HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 777

A RESOLUTION directing a study of parking on interstate highways and adjacent areas.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, that the department of transportation and the department of safety, in consultation with the Tennessee Trucking Association and the American Trucking Association, shall conduct a study relative to safety issues involving tractor trailers and other large motor vehicles parking alongside interstate highways and adjacent areas, including, but not limited to, medians, right-of-ways, rest areas, parking areas, and entrance and exit ramps.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the department of transportation and the department of safety shall report their findings and recommendations relative to such study, including any proposed legislation, to the One Hundred Seventh General Assembly no later than January 11, 2011.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that an enrolled copy of this resolution be transmitted to the commissioner of transportation and the commissioner of safety.
