

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 44

A RESOLUTION to authorize transmittal of the budget document.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 9-4-5105(b), requires the governor to transmit the budget document to the General Assembly prior to the first day of February; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 9-4-5105(b), further provides that the General Assembly, by joint resolution, may authorize transmittal of the budget document by a later date; and

WHEREAS, House Joint Resolution No. 11 of the One Hundred Sixth General Assembly authorized transmittal of the state budget document for fiscal year 2009-2010 at any time prior to the close of business in both houses on February 9, 2009; however, in light of legislation currently pending before the United States Congress, it is prudent to specify a later date for transmittal of the state budget document; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 9-4-5105, the General Assembly authorizes the transmittal of the state budget document or documents for fiscal year 2009-2010 at any time prior to the close of business in both houses on Tuesday, March 31, 2009.
