SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 177

A RESOLUTION regarding the joint convention of the Senate and the House of Representatives to be held on March 23, 2009, pursuant to Senate Joint Resolution No. 166.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that the scope and purpose of the March 23, 2009, joint convention of the Senate and the House of Representatives, to be held pursuant to Senate Joint Resolution No. 166, be expanded to include the election of a new member of the State Election Commission in order to fill the unexpired term recently vacated by the resignation of Mark Goins.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such joint convention be convened at 5:30 p.m. (CDT) and that such election be conducted immediately prior to the Governor's budget address.
