AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 29; Section 4-5-319 and Section 50-7-704, relative to the board of review, department of labor and workforce development.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-5-319(a), is amended by deleting the language "and board of review under title 50, chapter 7,".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-29-232(a), is amended by deleting subdivision (6) in its entirety.

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of § 4-29-112 or any other law to the contrary, the board of review, department of labor and workforce development, created by § 50-7-601, shall terminate and shall cease to exist upon the effective date of this act.

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 50-7-704, is amended by deleting the section and by substituting instead the following:

50-7-704. No person shall be excused from attending and testifying or from producing books, papers, correspondence, memoranda and other records before the commissioner, an unemployment hearing officer, or any duly authorized representative of any of them, or in obedience to the subpoena of any of them in any cause or proceeding before the commissioner or an unemployment hearing officer, on the ground that the testimony or evidence, documentary or otherwise, required of the person may tend to incriminate the person or subject the person to a penalty or forfeiture; but no individual shall be prosecuted or subjected to any penalty or forfeiture for or on account of any transaction, matter or thing concerning which the individual is compelled after having claimed the individual's privilege against self-incrimination, to testify or produce evidence, documentary or otherwise, except that the individual so testifying shall not be exempt from prosecution and punishment for perjury committed in so testifying.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011, the public welfare requiring it.
