AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 47, Chapter 18, Part 55.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 47-18-5506(14), is amended by deleting the subdivision in its entirety and substituting instead the following:

(14) At the applicant's expense, the results of a state and national fingerprint-based criminal history records check conducted by the Federal Bureau of Investigation or the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation, covering every officer of the applicant and every employee or agent of the applicant who is authorized to have access to the trust account required by § 47-18-5522. The applicant shall either obtain electronically scanned fingerprints placed on standard Federal Bureau of Investigation or the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation applicant cards through a company that has contracted with the state to provide a fingerprinting service or the applicant shall provide the administrator with three (3) sets of classifiable fingerprints on standard Federal Bureau of Investigation or the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation applicant cards for processing by the Federal Bureau of Investigation or the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
