AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-4-103, relative to residence qualifications of election officials.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-4-103(a), is amended by deleting the subsection in its entirety and by substituting instead the following language:

Officers of elections, judges, machine operators, precinct registrars and assistant precinct registrars shall be registered voters and shall reside in the county in which they are appointed to serve.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011, the public welfare requiring it.
