AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-29-204, relative to restoration of citizenship.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-29-204(3)(B), is amended by adding "or any violation containing the same elements and designated as a felony in any other state or federal court" after the word "felony" and before the semi-colon ";".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-29-204(3)(C), is amended by adding "or any violation containing the same elements and designated as a felony in any other state or federal court" after the word "felony".

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011, the public welfare requiring it.
