AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-515, relative to redacting social security numbers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-515(g), is amended by adding the following population figures in the chart at the end of the subsection:

<u>not less than</u>	<u>not more than</u>
71,300	71,400

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-515(f), is amended by deleting the period (.) at the end of the subsection and substituting instead the following:

and to counties having a population of not less than seventy-one thousand three hundred (71,300) nor more than seventy-one thousand four hundred (71,400) according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.


