AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 50, Chapter 6 and Title 50, Chapter 7, relative to employment security benefits for certain persons who have received workers' compensation benefits.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 50-7-218, is amended by adding the following language at the end of the section:

For the purposes of establishing a base period in cases involving persons receiving workers' compensation benefits for temporary total disability, the department shall exclude periods of such disability from the base period and determine the base period from the last four (4) completed quarters of work before any such disability.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011, the public welfare requiring it.
