AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 15, Chapter 2, relative to creating a Tennessee National Guard Day annually.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 15, Chapter 2, Part 1, is amended by adding a new section thereto, as follows:

15-2-122.

March 3 of each year shall be observed as "Tennessee National Guard Day" to be proclaimed as such by the governor, to honor and recognize Tennessee National Guard personnel for their service and sacrifices in defense of our nation and for responding to domestic missions within the borders of our state. This day shall not be a legal holiday as defined in Section 15-1-101.


SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.


