AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57, Chapter 4, relative to consumption of alcoholic beverages on premises of restaurants and limited service restaurants.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102(21)(A)(iii), is amended by deleting the first sentence and substituting instead the following:

The gross revenue from the sale of prepared food is fifty percent (50%) or less than the gross revenue from the sale of alcoholic beverages and beer; provided, however, gross revenue of more than fifty percent (50%) from the sale of prepared food shall not prevent a facility from receiving a "limited service restaurant" license or subject such facility to a fine from the commission for having gross revenue of more than fifty percent (50%) from the sale of prepared food.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102(29)(A), is amended by deleting the language "seventy-five (75) people" and substituting instead the language "forty (40) people".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-301(b)(1)(R), is amended by deleting the first table labeled (i) through (v) for restaurants and substituting instead the following:

(i) 40----74 seats	\$ 650
(ii) 75 — 125 seats	\$ 750
(iii) 126 — 175 seats	\$ 925
(iv) 176 — 225 seats	\$ 975
(v) 226 — 275 seats	\$1100
(vi) 276 seats and more	\$1200

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-301(b)(1)(W)(i), is amended by deleting the language "but not more than 50%".


SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
