AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 41-7-104, relative to fees.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:


SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 41-7-104, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subsection:

(c) A fee of ten cents (10¢) shall be collected for each completed telephone call made by an inmate housed in a local jail or workhouse. Such fees shall be remitted by the telephone service provider to the state treasurer each quarter and credited to a special account in the state general fund designated as the local correctional officer training fund to be used exclusively to fund certification training provided through the institute for local correctional personnel within the state. The institute's board of control shall approve all expenditures from the fund. Funds deposited in the account shall not revert to the general fund at the end of any fiscal year. On or before February 1, 2013, and by February 1 of each subsequent year, the institute shall report to the chairs of the State and Local Government Committees and Finance, Ways and Means Committees of the Senate and the House of Representatives on the fund's reserves and expenditures, which report shall include at least the following information for the prior calendar year: the amount of available reserves, the amount of expenditures made from the fund, and the manner of making such expenditures.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012, the public welfare requiring it.
