AN ACT to name the pathway surrounding the Tennessee Bicentennial Mall in honor of Andrea Conte.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. The outer circumference of the pathway system surrounding the Tennessee bicentennial mall in Nashville, Davidson County, is hereby designated the "Andrea Conte Pedestrian Pathway".

SECTION 2. The department of environment and conservation is directed to erect suitable signs or affix suitable markers designating such pathway as the "Andrea Conte Pedestrian Pathway".


SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
