### SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 214

A RESOLUTION to name a Tennessee National Guard Armory in Tullahoma in honor of Command Sergeant Major Howard Boswell.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that the Tennessee National Guard Armory located at 1202 East Carroll Street in Tullahoma, Coffee County, is hereby designated the "Command Sergeant Major Howard Boswell National Guard Armory".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Department of Military is directed to cause the erection of suitable signs designating such edifice as the "Command Sergeant Major Howard Boswell National Guard Armory".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the General Assembly recognizes that the cost of the manufacture and installation of such signs shall be borne by the federal government, and this act shall become operative only if the federal government manufactures and installs such signs or agrees to pay the Department of Military the total cost of the manufacture and installation of such signs. Such payment by the federal government shall be made prior to any expenditure by the state for the manufacture or installation of such signs.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that an enrolled copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Adjutant General.
