AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4; Title 5; Title 6; Title 7; Title 38; Title 43; Title 44; Title 45; Title 48; Title 53; Title 55; Title 56; Title 57; Title 59; Title 60; Title 62; Title 67; Title 68 and Title 71, relative to licenses and registrations.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-9-102, is amended by adding the following language as new, appropriately designated subsections:


(d) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, a registration issued pursuant to this part shall not expire immediately upon the death of the registrant. Such registration shall continue to be effective for the locations designated in such registration for a period of at least sixty (60) days; provided, such 60-day period may be extended by the commissioner for good cause.

(e) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, a registration issued pursuant to this part shall expire upon notification to the department by the location registered with the department that the registrant is no longer an employee or agent of the location.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013, the public welfare requiring it.
