AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 4, relative to purchases of special license plates.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. The department of revenue is directed to study the establishment of a program to authorize the sale of nonrefundable gift vouchers that may be redeemed by any person toward the fee required by § 55-4-203(d) for cultural and new specialty earmarked motor vehicle registration plates. The department of revenue shall file a written report, including any recommendations or proposed legislation, to the transportation and safety committee of the senate and the transportation committee of the house of representatives by December 31, 2013.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
