AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39, relative to criminal offenses.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-13-102(e)(1), is amended by deleting the last sentence and by substituting instead the following language:

However, the maximum fine shall be fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for an offense under subdivision (a)(1)(A), subdivision (a)(1)(B), subsection (c), or subsection (d) committed against any of the following persons who are discharging or attempting to discharge their official duties:

- (A) Law enforcement officer;
- (B) Firefighter;
- (C) Medical fire responder;
- (D) Paramedic;
- (E) Emergency medical technician; or
- (F) Any other first responder.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013, the public welfare requiring it.
