AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-4-120, relative to cosmetology schools.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-4-120, is amended by adding the following language as new, appropriately designated subsections:

(j) In addition to the schools currently operated pursuant to this section, the board shall establish rules and regulations for separate schools that specialize solely in natural hair styling, manicuring and the practice of aesthetics; provided, at a minimum, such specialized schools remain subject to the requirements of this section.

(k) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the board shall establish rules and regulations enabling schools operated pursuant to this section to develop courses of instruction in practice and theory that will satisfy the requirements of § 62-4-110, and that consist of:

(1) Earning fifty percent (50%) of the hours needed for the specific license from classroom training; and


(2) Fifty percent (50%) of the hours needed for the specific license from apprenticeship under the supervision of a person licensed pursuant to this chapter, who has at least ten (10) years of experience.

SECTION 2. The state board of cosmetology is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations to effectuate the purposes of this act. All such rules and regulations shall be promulgated in accordance with the Uniform Administrative Procedures Act, compiled in Title 4, Chapter 5.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of promulgating rules and regulations, this act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, this act shall take effect July 1, 2013, the public welfare requiring it.
