AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, relative to education.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, 49-7-2004(a)(7), is amended by deleting the subdivision and substituting instead the following:

(7) Institutions operated solely as auction schools, barber schools, schools of cosmetology or schools of electrology; provided, however, any barber school or school of cosmetology whose authorization by the department of commerce is denied by the United States Department of Education for student financial aid purposes may seek authorization from the Tennessee higher education commission under the Postsecondary Authorization Act of 1974, compiled in title 49, chapter 7, part 20, and shall thereafter be subject to all requirements of title 49, chapter 7, part 20;

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it, and shall expire and be of no force and effect after June 30, 2015; and on July 1, 2015, the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-7-2004(a)(7) are hereby revived and reenacted as such provisions were codified immediately prior to the effective date of this act.
