AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 67, Chapter 4, Part 16; Title 68, Chapter 211 and Chapter 457 of the Public Acts of 2013, relative to tires.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:


SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-211-802(a), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

() "Shredded" means shredded, chipped, chopped, quartered, sliced at least circumferentially, or otherwise processed and rendered not whole in a manner to effectively prevent a tire from floating, as determined by the board.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014, the public welfare requiring it.
