## PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 858

HOUSE BILL NO. 1640

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 29, Part 2 and Title 17, Chapter 5, Part 2, relative to the Tennessee board of judicial conduct.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-29-235(a), is amended by deleting subdivision (53) in its entirety.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-29-239(a), is amended by adding a new subdivision thereto, as follows:

( ) Tennessee board of judicial conduct, created by § 17-5-201;

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 17-5-201(a)(6), is amended by deleting the language "who are not judges" and substituting instead the language "who are not salaried judges".

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 17-5-201(a)(7), is amended by deleting the language "who are not judges" and substituting instead the language "who are not salaried judges".

SECTION 5. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 17-5-201(a)(8), is amended by deleting the language "who are not judges" and substituting instead the language "who are not salaried judges".

SECTION 6. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 17-5-207(b), is amended by adding the following language as a new subdivision thereto:

(9) A list of votes taken by each board member as follows:

(A) The member's name;

(B) The total number of times the member voted to dismiss a complaint while on an investigative panel; and

(C) The total number of times the member voted to authorize an investigation while on an investigative panel.

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.


