## PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 875

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57, Chapter 2, Part 1, relative to manufacturing of intoxicating liquors or drinks.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-2-103(d)(1), is amended by deleting the language "or" at the end of subdivision (C); by deleting the period and substituting instead the language "; or" at the end of subdivision (D); and by adding the following as a new subdivision thereto:

(E) Any county that has at least three (3) establishments, located in such county or in any municipality in such county, licensed under § 57-4-102(26) to sell alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption if such county was included in subsection (d) as it read prior to July 1, 2013.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.


