AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 7, Chapter 88, relative to development zones.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 7-88-108(a), is amended by adding the following language after the second sentence:

A municipality or public authority shall include a resolution adopted by the county legislative body with any application for approval of the tourism development zone which would utilize any portion of the local option sales tax revenues designated for schools pursuant to § 67-6-712(a)(1). The resolution shall provide whether the county legislative body is in support of, in opposition to, or neutral regarding the application. Upon request by the municipality or the public authority, the county legislative body shall provide such resolution not less than five (5) days after the next regularly scheduled meeting of the county legislative body.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
