AN ACT to amend Chapter 306 of the Private Acts of 1951; as amended by Chapter 451 of the Private Acts of 1953; Chapter 364 of the Private Acts of 1972; Chapter 182 of the Private Acts of 1980; Chapter 140 of the Private Acts of 1986; Chapter 158 of the Private Acts of 1994; Chapter 75 of the Private Acts of 2008 and Chapter 61 of the Private Acts of 2010; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the City of Westmoreland.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 306 of the Private Acts of 1951, as amended by Chapter 451 of the Private Acts of 1953, Chapter 364 of the Private Acts of 1972, Chapter 182 of the Private Acts of 1980, Chapter 140 of the Private Acts of 1986, Chapter 158 of the Private Acts of 1994, Chapter 75 of the Private Acts of 2008, Chapter 61 of the Private Acts of 2010, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended in Article III, Section 5, by deleting the third sentence and substituting instead the language "However, the City Attorney, City Judge, and City Recorder are exempt from the residency requirements set forth in the previous sentence."

SECTION 2. Chapter 306 of the Private Acts of 1951, as amended by Chapter 75 of the Private Acts of 2008, Chapter 61 of the Private Acts of 2010, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended in Article VI, Section 2, by deleting the first sentence and substituting instead the language "No person shall be eligible for the office of City Recorder who holds any other public office."

SECTION 3. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of the City of Westmoreland. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the City of Westmoreland and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 4. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 3.


