AN ACT to amend Chapter 111 of the Private Acts of 1951; as amended by Chapter 57 of the Private Acts of 1957; Chapter 80 of the Private Acts of 1989; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the Jackson County highway commissioner.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 111 of the Private Acts of 1951, as amended by Chapter 57 of the Private Acts of 1957, Chapter 80 of the Private Acts of 1989, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by deleting the following language from Section 2:

In each county to which this Act applies the Commissioner shall file with the Quarterly County Court at least five days prior to the date set for their regular meeting thereof a detailed report of his expenditures during such quarter. Such quarterly report shall likewise contain full details as to any and all purchases of road equipment made during such preceding quarter where such purchase is in excess of \$1,000.00; and such report shall contain a description of the equipment, the price paid therefor and the person, firm or corporation from whom purchased.

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of Jackson County. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the legislative body and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 2.
