AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 10, Chapter 7, relative to the redaction of social security identification numbers on public records.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-515(g), is amended by deleting the subsection in its entirety and substituting instead:

A county register of deeds may redact any social security number that is found on a recorded document maintained on a computer or removable computer storage media, including CD-ROM disk, if the records are stored in a manner that permits redaction.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-515(f), is amended by deleting the subsection in its entirety and redesignating the remaining subsection.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
