## **PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 113**

### **SENATE BILL NO. 440**

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 36, Chapter 1, Part 1, relative to adoption.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 36-1-112(a)(1)(A), is amended by deleting the subdivision in its entirety and substituting instead the following:

(A) A person who executed a surrender may revoke the surrender at any time within three (3) calendar days of the date of the surrender.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 36-1-112(a)(1)(C), is amended by deleting the subdivision in its entirety and substituting instead the following:

(C) The three-day period for revocation of the surrender shall not limit the court's authority to order the revocation of the surrender pursuant to § 36-1-118.

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 36-1-112(a)(1)(F), is amended by deleting the language "ten-day period" wherever it appears and substituting instead the language "three-day period".

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 36-1-111(x)(1), is amended by deleting the language "ten-day period" and substituting instead the language "three-day period".

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.


