AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 5, Chapter 1, relative to removal of overgrown vegetation and accumulated debris.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 5-1-115(e), is amended by adding the following language as a new subdivision:

Notwithstanding subdivision (e)(1), in any county having a population of not less than twenty-seven thousand seven hundred (27,700) nor more than twenty-seven thousand eight hundred (27,800), according to the 2010 federal census or any subsequent federal census, subsection (c) permitting a county to remedy such dangerous conditions shall apply to any parcel of property, including any parcel upon which an owner-occupied residence is located.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.


