AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 40, Chapter 32, relative to expunctions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-32-102, is amended by deleting the section in its entirety and substituting instead the following:

(a) The chief administrative official of a municipal, county, or state agency and the clerk of each court where the records are recorded shall remove and destroy the records within sixty (60) days from the date of the expunction order issued under § 40-32-101.

(b) The Tennessee bureau of investigation shall remove expunged records from the person's criminal history within sixty (60) days from the date of receipt of the expunction order.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-32-101(d)(1), is amended by adding the language "within thirty (30) days from the date of the expunction order" immediately after the language "Tennessee bureau of investigation".

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.


