AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57, Chapter 4 and Title 57, Chapter 5, relative to intoxicating liquors.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-201, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

() Notwithstanding any law or rule to the contrary, upon collection of a fifty-dollar licensing fee, the commission may issue temporary licenses not to exceed thirty (30) days to any new applicant for a license issued pursuant to this chapter.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102(8)(F)(ii), is amended by adding the following numbers to the population table:

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102(8)(F)(i), is amended by adding the following language as a new subdivision:

() The premises, as provided in § 57-4-101(a)(2) for a club, whether such parcels comprising the club premises are contiguous or not, shall also include the golf course, including beverage carts; tennis courts; all areas of the clubhouse; the area immediately surrounding the swimming pool, if a club offers such amenities; and all other related recreational facilities.

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-101(a)(2), is amended by deleting the language "members and guests of members" and substituting instead the language "members and guests".

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
