AN ACT to name the National Guard Armory in the city of Lobelville in honor of Sgt. First Class Michael Braden.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. (a) The National Guard Armory in the city of Lobelville shall be named "The Michael Braden Armory Building" in honor of Sgt. First Class Michael Braden's twenty-five (25) years of service to the National Guard, part of which was served at the Lobelville armory.

(b) The provisions of this act shall not be construed to be an appropriation of funds, and no funds shall be obligated or expended pursuant to this act unless such funds are specifically appropriated by the general appropriations act.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
