AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 21, Part 3, relative to employment litigation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-21-313(a), is amended by adding the following language as a new subdivision (1), and by redesignating the existing subdivision (1) and the remaining subdivisions accordingly:

(1) In the case of a cause of action arising under § 50-1-304 and an employer who has less than eight (8) employees at the time the cause of action arose, twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000);

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it, and shall apply to causes of action accruing on or after the effective date of this act.


