AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39; Title 43; Title 44; Title 53 and Title 63, Chapter 12, relative to recording government actions involving animals.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 43, Chapter 1, Part 1, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

43-1-102. Unless otherwise prohibited by federal law, the owner of any animal that is subject to an inspection in this state for the purpose of determining compliance with any statutory or regulatory requirement shall be permitted to personally record such inspection by audiovisual means or designate an agent to record such inspection by audiovisual means.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
