AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 67, Chapter 4, Part 6, relative to substance abuse prevention.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-4-601, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

() Notwithstanding the apportionment provisions of § 67-4-606 or this section, upon the adoption of a resolution by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of a county legislative body, any amounts collected pursuant to this section may be used by the county legislative body for substance abuse prevention purposes in addition to other purposes identified by this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
