AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-21-401; Section 8-4-115; Title 16; Title 18 and Section 39-17-1316, relative to disposition information.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 18-4-103, is amended by adding the following as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

Notify the Tennessee bureau of investigation of final disposition of criminal proceedings against a person as soon as practicable but no later than thirty (30) days after final disposition of the criminal proceedings;

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 18-4-203(b), is amended by deleting the subsection and substituting instead the following:

(b) It is the duty of the clerk of the general sessions court to:

(1) Keep all dockets required by title 16, chapter 15;

(2) Write all minute entries required;

(3) Promptly make any and all entries necessitated by §§ 16-15-101 - 16-15-711, 18-4-201, 18-4-202, 20-12-143, and 27-5-108, and former §§ 40-118, 40-424, and 40-425 (repealed); and

(4) Notify the Tennessee bureau of investigation of final disposition of criminal proceedings against a person as soon as practicable but no later than thirty (30) days after final disposition of the criminal proceedings.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
